The first course begins on Wednesday, March 10, 2010 (5:00 pm) and ends on Sunday, March 14, 2010 (1:40 pm). The second course begins on Wednesday, March 24, 2010 (5:00 pm) and ends on Sunday, March 28, 2010 (1:40 pm). The third course begins on Wednesday, April 14, 2010 (5:00 pm) and ends on Sunday, April 18, 2010 (1:40 pm). The fourth course begins on Wednesday, April 21, 2010 (5:00 pm) and ends on Sunday, April 25, 2010 (1:40 pm).

The fees are all inclusive. THE FACULTY OCCASIONALLY VARIES BETWEEN COURSES (CASES DO NOT VARY). THE VAST MAJORITY OF THE FACULTY HAVE EXTENSIVE EXPERIENCE IN BOARD EXAMINATION PREPARATION.

UNLIKE MOST COURSES, THIS COURSE INCLUDES ALL SNACKS AND MEALS SO YOU CAN FOCUS YOUR TIME ON THE PURPOSE OF THE COURSE, PREPARING FOR THE BOARDS.
