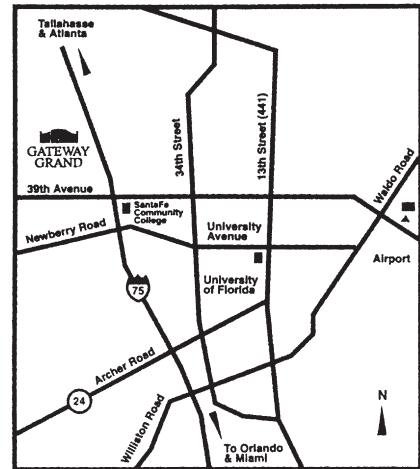


ACCREDITATION
